

ACCEPTABLE PHOTO ID'S FOR LEGAL TESTING

Expired ID's are not acceptable under any circumstance

Petitioner's for Immigration, Passport, Citizenship and Visa Purposes:

- Fully-valid, undamaged **United States** passport book or passport card (with recognizable photo)
- Certificate of Naturalization with affixed photo
- Certificate of Citizenship with affixed photo
- In-state, fully valid driver's license (may not be temporary, learner's permit or interim)
- Permanent resident card (Green Card)

All Other Participants and Beneficiaries:

- In-state, fully valid driver's license (temporary and learner's permit OK; interim OK if copy of expired driver's license is provided as well)
- Fully-valid, undamaged passport book or passport card (with recognizable photo) **US or Foreign.**
- Certificate of Naturalization with affixed photo
- Certificate of Citizenship with affixed photo
- Government employee ID (city, county, state, or federal)
- U.S. military or military dependent ID (active duty or retired military and their dependents, and DoD civilians)
- Matricula Consular (Mexican Consular ID) commonly used by a parent of a U.S. citizen child applicant

• Permanent resident card (Green Card)

Refugee Petition for **Spouse / Unmarried Child Only** with Valid Refugee Status:

- Same as All Other Participants and Beneficiaries Section Above
- Photo ID supporting petitioner's refugee status
