
ACCEPTABLE PHOTO ID's FOR LEGAL TESTING

Expired ID's are not acceptable under any circumstance

Petitioner's for Immigration, Passport, Citizenship and Visa Purposes:

- Fully-valid, undamaged **United States** passport book or passport card (with recognizable photo)
- Certificate of Naturalization with **affixed photo**
- Certificate of Citizenship with **affixed photo**
- In-state, fully valid driver's license (**may not be temporary, learner's permit or interim**)
- Permanent resident card (Green Card)

All Other Participants and Beneficiaries:

- In-state, fully valid driver's license (**temporary and learner's permit OK; interim OK if copy of expired driver's license is provided as well**)
- Fully-valid, undamaged passport book or passport card (with recognizable photo) **US or Foreign.**
- Certificate of Naturalization with **affixed photo**
- Certificate of Citizenship with **affixed photo**
- Government employee ID (city, county, state, or federal)
- U.S. military or military dependent ID (active duty or retired military and their dependents, and DoD civilians)
- Matricula Consular (Mexican Consular ID) - commonly used by a parent of a U.S. citizen child applicant
- Permanent resident card (Green Card)

Refugee Petition for Spouse / Unmarried Child Only with Valid Refugee Status:

- Same as All Other Participants and Beneficiaries Section Above
- Photo ID supporting petitioner's refugee status
